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Dr. Kapogiannis is a board-certified infectious disease specialist in pediatrics and internal medicine, and the NICHD/NIH Scientific Director of the Adolescent Trials Network for HIV/AIDS Interventions, which is evaluating interventions for treatment and management of HIV infection and its complications among youth, as well as the prevention of HIV transmission in the adolescent population, including HIV vaccine and microbicide studies. He is also an adjunct associate professor of pediatrics at Johns Hopkins University where he provides care for at-risk and HIV-infected adolescents weekly. He has published over 60 original articles, reviews and book chapters on at-risk and HIV-infected adolescents and young adults across a variety of primary, secondary and tertiary prevention topics and currently holds the IND to the only US licensure trial of HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis using the antiretroviral medication Truvada among at-risk adolescents and young adults ages 15 to 22 years.
